

## Webinar Presenter - Dr. David Altschul

Dr. David Altschul is a dual trained cerebrovascular neurosurgery who is Chief of the Division of Cerebrovascular Neurosurgery in the Department of Neurological Surgery, and Surgical Director of the Comprehensive Stroke Center at Montefiore Medical Center in the Bronx, New York. He is also the Associate Residency Program Director and Associate Professor of Neurosurgery and Radiology at the Albert Einstein School of Medicine.

He is a native New Yorker, who did residency training at Montefiore Medical Center, and neuroendovascular fellowship training with Dr. Alejandro Berenstein at St.-Luke's-Roosevelt Hospital. He went to undergraduate college at Johns Hopkins University, and medical school at SUNY-Downstate in Brooklyn, NY.
